

## T-BALL RULES

- 1. All players will bat and play in the field every inning. Each team will bat the number of players that they have attending the game each inning. There will only be 6 infielders the remaining players must play in the outfield.
- 2. Games will consist of 3 innings or a 1-hour time limit, whichever comes first.
- 3. All batted balls must go beyond the I2-foot arch to be considered fair.
- 4. Any thrown ball that comes into the infield and is controlled by an infielder will become dead and all play stops. If a runner has crossed the halfway lines, the runner can advance to the nearest base, if not the runner must return to the last base he/she touched.
- 5. Runners cannot advance on any overthrown ball that goes out of the field of play.
- 6. Runners cannot leave the base until the ball is hit. All players making an out will not be allowed to stay on base.
- 7. After the third out all bases will be cleared.
- 8. Scoreboards will not be used due to this activity does not keep score or standings.
