

**MINTES**  
**City of Dillon Public Hearing**  
**June 29, 2020**

The June 29, 2020 Public Hearing for the 2020-2021 Municipal Budget of the City Council was held in the Council Chambers of the City-County Complex Building located at 401 West Main Street in Dillon, SC. Notices of this regular meeting of City Council was provided to the media and individuals requesting a copy of the agenda informing them of the date, location, and time of the meeting.

- I. **Call to Order** - Mayor Pro Tem, Dr. Wallace called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Everyone stood for the Pledge of Allegiance. Dr. Wallace gave the invocation.
- II. **Approval of Agenda**  
Councilmember Cousar made a motion to approve the Agenda. Councilmember Jackson seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
- III. **Public Comments on the Budget Ordinance**  
None.
- IV. **Ordinance #20-09 – Municipal Budget for 2020-2021- 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading**  
Dr. Wallace explained some things that would be in the Budget. He stated all full-time employees would receive a \$1,200 per year pay raise to help pay for the new health insurance to start on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. The health insurance will cost employees around \$100 per month. He said we budgeted \$147,000 for two police cars, a truck in the Fire Department, a mower and bush hog in Public Works. There will be a 2mill tax increase. Dr. Wallace stated there will be no increase in Sanitation rates. The budget also includes a tool body truck, tractor, 8inch bypass pump, and a vehicle in Water & Sewer. There will be no increase in Water & Sewer rates. Ordinance #20-09 adopting a budget for 2020-2021 was presented for second reading. Councilmember Cousar made a motion to approve Ordinance #20-09 adopting the 2020-2021 Municipal Budget and Councilman Washington seconded. The motion passed 6-0.
- V. **Adjourn**  
With no further business to discuss, Councilmember Jackson made a motion to adjourn. The motion passed 6-0. The meeting adjourned at 7:10pm.
