II. Approval of Agenda

Councilmember Washington made a motion to approve the agenda. Councilmember Eller seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

III. Budget for 2021-2022

Glen Wagner gave proposed balanced budget for Water and Sewer. Included in the budget is a 2% salary increase and 1% merit raise. Also included are 3 computers for water and sewer administration, 1 confined space monitor, 1 trench box, 1 lift, 1 truck, 1 mini excavator, 1 meter truck, and a hand-held device reader. Glen also included two mowers for the Golf Course. Next \$62,444 was included in the Stormwater budget for the last payment for the vactor truck which is due in October. After much discussion, Council agreed to the proposed 2021-2022 Budget. The first reading on the Budget will be June 14, 2021 at the next regular Council Meeting.
